Established in 1920, following passage of the 19th amendment granting women the right to vote, the League is one of the nation's most respected grassroots organizations.

Nationwide, members in about 800 local leagues and Washington, DC, Hong Kong, and the Virgin Islands, work to empower citizens to shape better communities by providing information, education, and advocacy.

The League is proud to be non-partisan, neither supporting nor opposing candidates or political parties at all levels of government.

It has done this since its inception.



What the League Does

Hosts forums for candidates running for office.



Provides nonpartisan information about what voters will find on their ballots: who is running for office and candidate views. It also includes information about Vote By Mail and Voter Registration Applications and deadlines, election dates, polling place locations, voter qualifications, ballot initiatives and more.

Holds informational sessions on public policy issues such as health care, women's rights, children's welfare, environmental quality, immigration, transportation, housing and education.

Engages in Voters Services activities.

The League of Women Voters of Northern Valley was founded in 1946 as the Closter League.

By 1964, it included 11 municipalities in the Northern Valley and was renamed the LWV of Northern Valley.

Today the Northern Valley League draws members from Alpine, Bergenfield, Cliffside Park, Closter, Cresskill, Demarest, Dumont, Edgewater, Emerson, Englewood, Englewood Cliffs, Fort Lee, Hackensack, Harrington Park, Haworth, Hillsdale, Leonia, Montvale, New Milford, Northvale, Norwood, Old Tappan, Park Ridge, River Vale, Rockleigh, Tenafly, Washington Township, Westwood, and Woodcliff Lake.
